Missing persons and Re-Unification:

- Primary search for victims has been completed.
- Secondary search in Mayfield has been completed.
- Candle factory search has been completed.
- Graves County search began 12/13
- Information is being collected at His-House and coordinated through the local coroner's office.
- Door-to-door checks began in county 12/14

Facilities and Infrastructure:

- The mayor's office is relocating to Fountain Square.
- EMS station one is relocating to Mega Power behind the old Kubata.
- Transportation cabinet's cleanup effort of city roads is 60% complete.
- Damage assessment start date has been moved to 12/15
- Postal services in Mayfield are suspended, packages will go through the Paducah Office.
- Linwood Parking Lot: Fed-Ex and UPS will be set up and calling citizens if there are medication packages to be picked up.
- P.O. Boxes at the Mayfield Post Office have been relocated to the post office in Hickory, Ky, behind Pilgrim's
- The Hickman County 911 line is not currently functional.
- The EOC is working on setting up temporary dump sites.

Communications:

- A "No-Burn" order is in place in the city and county for homeowners discarding debris.
- Check the Graves County Office of Emergency Management Facebook page for daily updates.
- A FEMA vehicle will be set up at the old Walmart to answer questions.

Schools:

- Graves County Schools will be closed this week
- Fancy Farm, Wingo, Symsonia will be offering free breakfast and lunch to the public
